

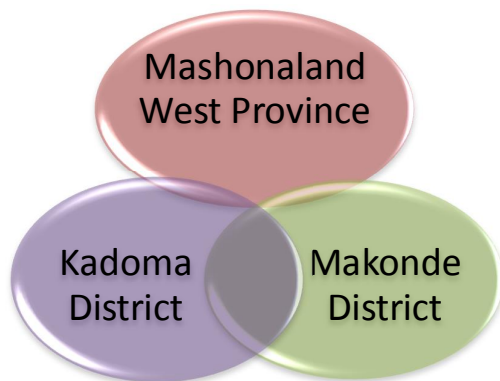
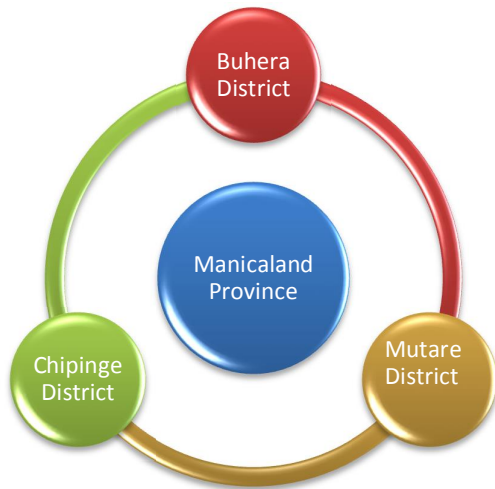

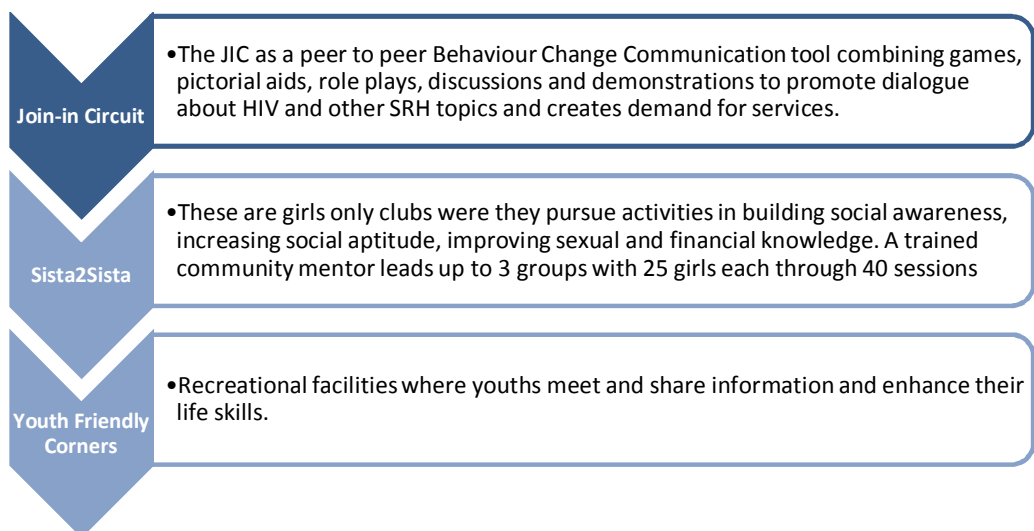
**Title: Strengthening HIV
& SRHR Service Uptake
by Youths in Zimbabwe**

Operational Areas & Target Group: Project is implemented in five districts from two Provinces of Zimbabwe, with the aim of strengthening SRHR information dissemination and service uptake among young people aged 10 – 24 years.



District stakeholders from the above mentioned districts were engaged in identification of operational areas i.e. 45 wards (nine in each district). Criterion for identification was hot spot mapping of areas that would increase vulnerability and susceptibility of young people to HIV and STIs. These are wards where mining activities are being done, Growth Points, very remote and hard to reach, areas with harmful religious and cultural beliefs. Forty five health facilities (9 in each district) were also identified in the same wards for linking SRH service provision.
